

Quebec District Meeting: Strategy Meeting in Outaouais with National President Roy Goodall

From 6 to 8 May 2025, the six branches of the Quebec District met with National President Roy Goodall in Montebello for a strategic working meeting. At the heart of the discussions: the state of the Quebec network, regional priorities for the coming months, and avenues of influence within the national committees.

Participants collectively reflected on governance issues in the context of the ongoing restructuring of the NAFR. The upcoming Annual Members' Meeting (AMM), scheduled for June 2025 in Gatineau, promises to be crucial for ratifying profound changes.

Service standards, transparency of decisions at the national level, and advocacy, especially in relations with provincial governments, were also discussed. Branches expressed their desire for better support to meet members' needs.

This meeting enabled an open, respectful, and forward-looking dialogue to strengthen the role of the branches within the Association. Several concrete proposals will be submitted to the National Council and the AMM.
